
Junior school council positioning new mirrors in the toilets.

Nursery have been celebrating Chinese New Year. They enjoyed using the chopsticks and dressing up in Chinese clothes.










In Science Year 6 have been investigating how Mentos react with different liquids. Lilly had lots of fun measuring the reaction and did her best not to
