Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you have had a lovely Summer holiday and enjoyed the hot weather we have had. It has been lovely seeing all the pupils return to school this week, excited and settled in their new class. We have been busy over the Summer holidays, having a new track installed for bikes and scooters. This has already proved a huge hit with pupils. Children are encouraged to bring their own bikes and scooters as they can use the track before school and during breaks. We have also invested in some playground equipment.

As we return to school, can I remind you of our uniform policy for pupils:

School Uniform: Pupils should wear the following items of clothes, all labelled with their names.

Sweatshirt: Green
Polo shirt: Yellow
Cardigan/Pullover: Green
Trousers: Dark Grey
Skirts: Dark Grey
Summer Dresses: Green and White Gingham
Shoes: Black

P.E. Kit: Pupils can come to school wearing their P.E. kits on the day of the lesson. This is something we will continue post Covid as it has been more efficient. Please note that Sports Team Kits/tops should not be worn for PE lessons.

Polo/ T-Shirt : Plain White
Shorts: Black
Tracksuit bottoms: Black
Sweatshirt/Tracksuit top: Black
Trainers: Appropriate for outdoor lessons

Forest School/Life Skills/Builders Yard: Pupils can come into school wearing suitable clothing. This should be clothing you don't mind getting muddy and appropriate for the activities they will complete. We recommend bringing wellies in a bag, especially in the Winter months or they can wear old trainers. As a school we have a limited supply of spare wellies which can be used.

Mobile Phones: Pupils do not need to bring mobile phones with them to school. However, we are aware that pupils in Year 5/6 may walk home alone. If they do bring a phone to school for this purpose, they must hand it in to the class teacher at the start of the day where they will be stored until 3:15. The school does not take any responsibility for the loss/damage of mobile phones.



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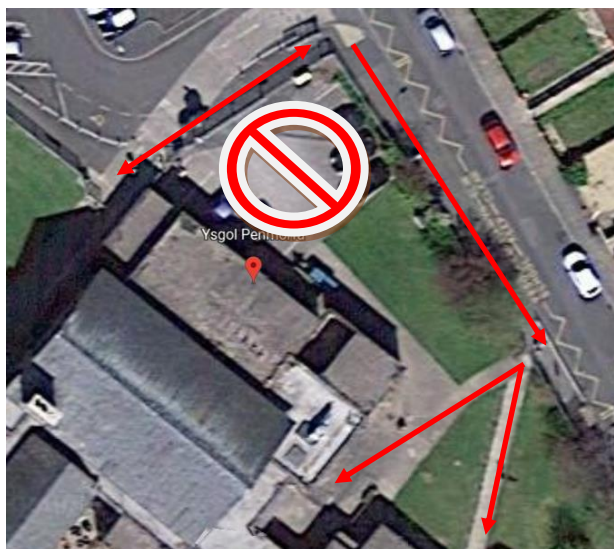
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Medication: Please ensure that if your child needs medication during school time that it is taken to the office. No medication can be given without the correct paperwork being filled in by a Parent/Carer.

If you haven't already, please join your child's class Seesaw where information, updates and pictures will be shared of your child's learning journey. If you require another QR code, please ask and we can send another home. We are aware of changes in the app which were made at the end of the last academic year which have impacted this year. If you are having problems, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher. We will share key dates for the academic year with you shortly which will contain Parents' evenings, Christmas Events and any other key dates for your information.

Carpark: As you will be aware the parking at Penmorfa can be extremely difficult at times, especially when we have poor weather. We have been in regular contact with county to try and create a solution to this, with the possibility of extending the carpark or adjusting the pavement to allow two-way traffic. Health and Safety were on site last year and have advised that our small car park should **not** be used for walking through by parents and children. Please follow the arrows on the map to access the office or Reception areas. This will ensure pupil safety, which is always paramount.
