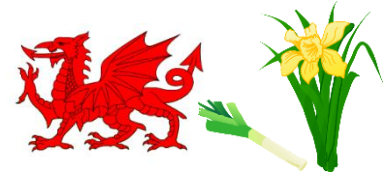
4SG have been tasting different smoothies ready to design and make their own in the next few weeks.
