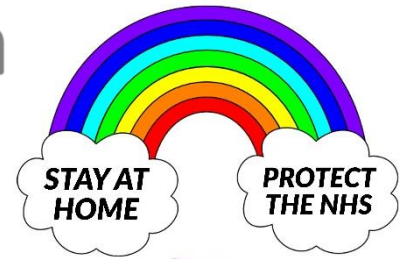

Declan has created a wonderful bug hotel!



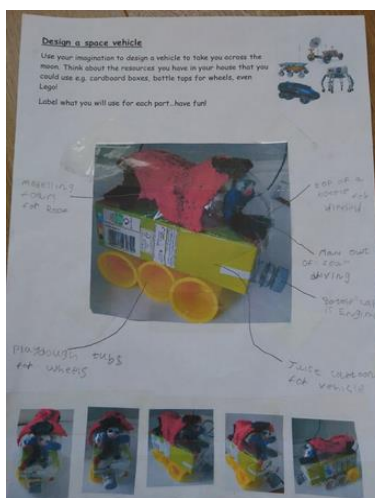
Sophia and George spinning on their UFO swing in the garden as part of year 3's topic on Space.
