Important Notice!

If you have a child who starts at an earlier time or finishes at a later time than their brother or sister and you wish to drop/pick them both off/up at roughly the same time please can you do this at the earlier time in the morning and later time in the afternoon.

For example, if one starts at 8.45am and the other at 9.15am then drop the first child at 8.45am and go straight to the other child's class early. On pick up pick the child who is due to finish at 2.45pm at 3.10pm then go to collect the other child at their set time of 3.15pm.
