The School Council would like to re-launch our Uniform re-use scheme for anyone who would needs items of school uniform.

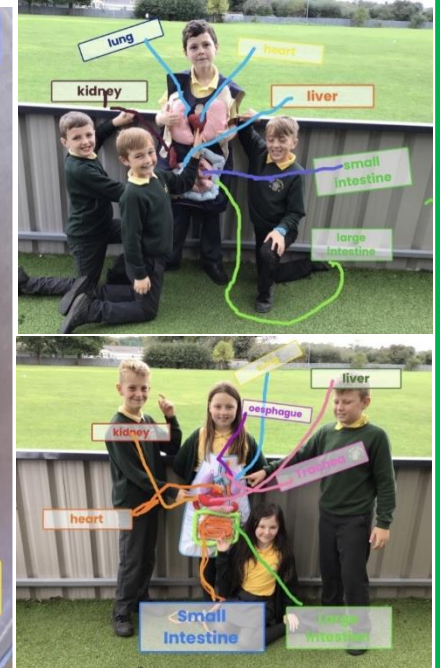

Denbighshire County Councils Play Ranger service are running 'Let's Play Out' open access play sessions during October half term where children have the chance to:

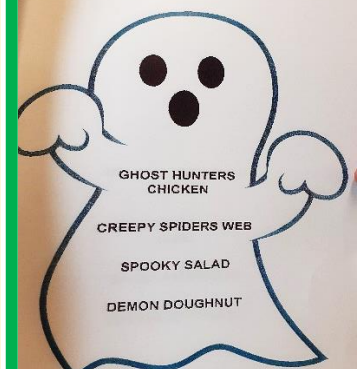
