It's FREE to take part, and last year 75% of children taking part improved their reading skills over the holidays.

How can my child take part?

In the library

Visit your local library and sign up. Your child will: Set a reading goal for the summer and borrow and read books, eBooks and audiobooks. Your child can choose anything they like to read! Receive a Challenge folder and collect special stickers and rewards for reading.

Take part online at www.summerrreadingchallenge.org.uk Sign up on the official Challenge website. Set a reading goal and get tips for accessing books for free at home. Unlock digital badges and online rewards, including a printable certificate

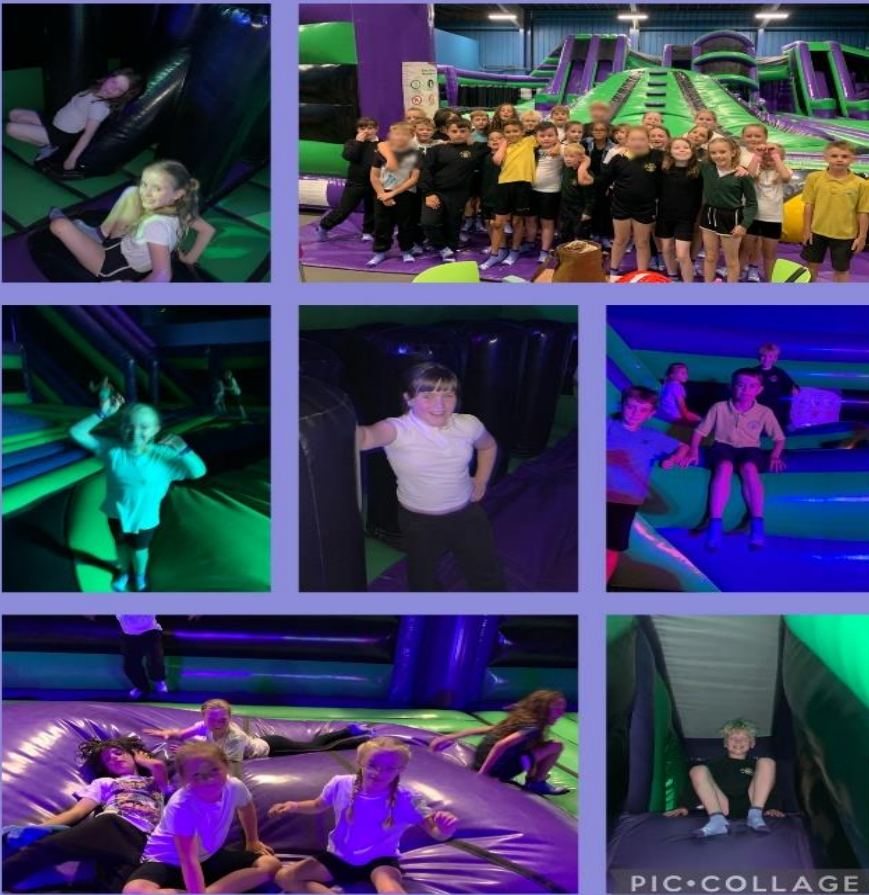
