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Attendance and Punctuality


As we are at the start of a new school year I'd like to remind you about the importance of your child's attendance. Please make every effort to get your child/children to school on time. Doors open at 8.45am and we also have a breakfast club provision available from 7.45am at a cost of £2 and from 8am for £1. Children can also attend the club at 8.30am which is free of charge.

Our Attendance target is 95%

Can I also remind you to contact the school office if your child is absent for any reason. We now have an answering service so when you ring school just press option 1 and leave a message, giving your child's name, class and the reason for absence. This will avoid us having to contact you to find out why your child/children are away.

What will happen if the absence is unauthorised?

- The school will decide if a Fixed Penalty Notice should be issued. If the school decide that a Fixed Penalty Notice is
- to be issued You will receive a letter from the school advising that it has referred the matter to the Local Authority and that a Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued:
- The school will inform the Local Authority that a Fixed Penalty Notice needs to be issued A Fixed Penalty Notice will be sent to you, acco
- an explanatory letter, the Notice gives you the opportunity to pay a penalty fine instead of being prosecuted in the criminal courts

Penalties for Unauthorised absence		
Timeline	One Child	Two Children
Peid within 28 days	£60 per parent	£60 per child = £120 per parent
After 28 days and before 42 days	£120 per parent	£120 per child = £240 per parent
After 42 days	You will receive a summons to appear before the Magistratus' Court on the grounds you have failed to secure your child's regular school attendance	You will receive a summons to appear before the Magistrates' Court on the grounds you have failed to secure your childnes's regular school attendance
