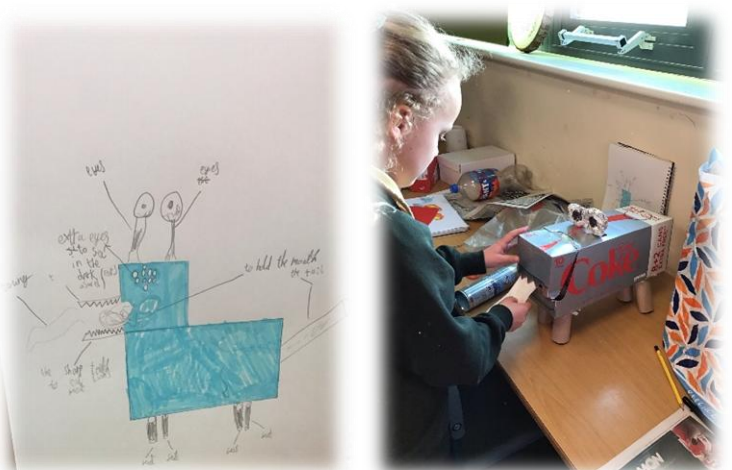
Nursery F have been excited to start their new topic about colours. They have enjoyed using the easel independently to paint colourful pictures.
